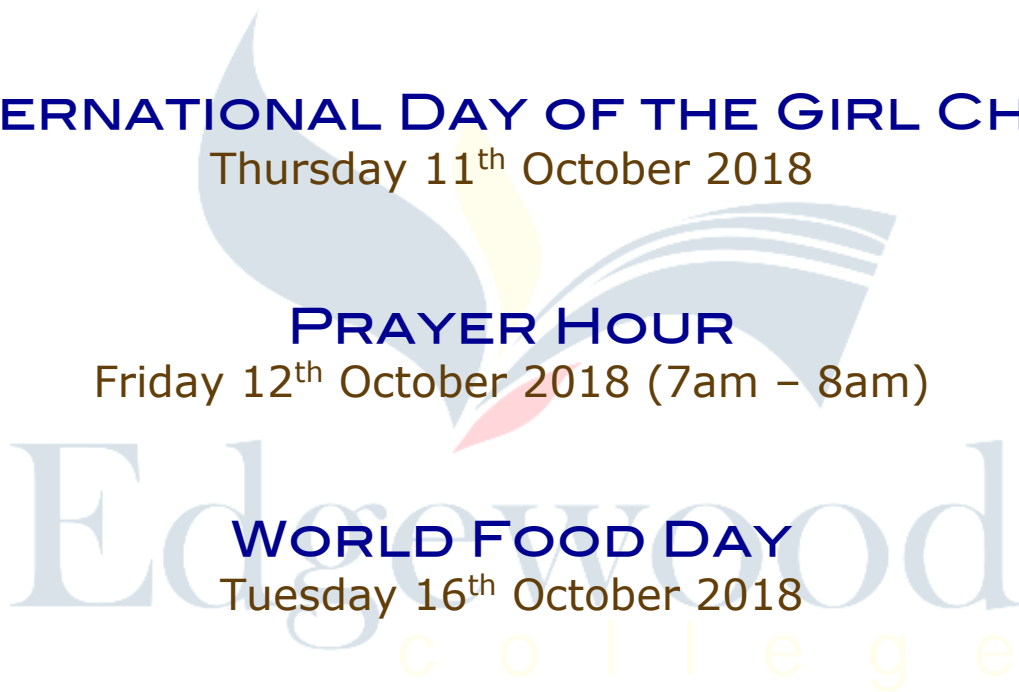



Independence Day celebration (1pm – 2:30pm on Friday 28th September 2018)



On Friday 28th September 2018, we will celebrate our nation's independence. We have already started learning about Nigeria's history, heritage and prospects. Each house plans to showcase its talents and teach the rest of the college community about Nigeria.

Our children will come to the college in their traditional Nigerian attires. It is time to check that the clothes still fit. If your child is in the hostel, you can bring the Nigerian attire to the school office.

The celebration will commence at 1pm. During the celebration, we will present the honour roll certificates and ties to those with very high academic achievements in the last term.

Independence Day weekend/Visiting Day

After the Independence Day celebration on Friday 28th September 2018, boarders can go home for the long weekend. They can be picked up from the hostel from 3:30pm on Friday 28th September 2018, but must return between 2pm and 6pm on Monday 1st October 2018.

Saturday 29th September 2018 is Visiting Day. Boarders who remain in the hostel for the long weekend can receive visitors between 10am and 4pm. Parents may bring food and drinks for a family lunch. Please do not bring items that are not allowed in the hostel or college.



Extracurricular activities

So as to give the students sufficient time to prepare for the Independence Day celebration, extracurricular activities will now commence on 2nd October 2018.

Students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be asked to choose three activities for the term. They can choose from karate, chess, Model United Nations, cookery, public speaking, art and craft, music, swimming, table tennis, soccer, basketball, volleyball and many more. Once selected, they will be required to stick to the three activities till the end of the term.

Payment cards and pickup cards

We have now captured images of our students or the school information system, pickup cards and payment cards.

The bank will issue new payment cards within 9 working days. The payment cards can be used as student ID cards and for purchases in the tuck shop. For now, tuck shop vouchers can be purchased from the bursar.

The pickup cards will be issued within next week. They should be brought to the college during afternoon pickups.

Please remember that students should arrive at the college between 7am and 7:15am. Students should be picked up at 3:30pm (4pm in the sixth form).



We do not have the resources to supervise children before 7am and after 4pm. Please make suitable arrangements for pickup.

Possible solutions are: school bus, hostel accommodation and car share arrangements with other parents.

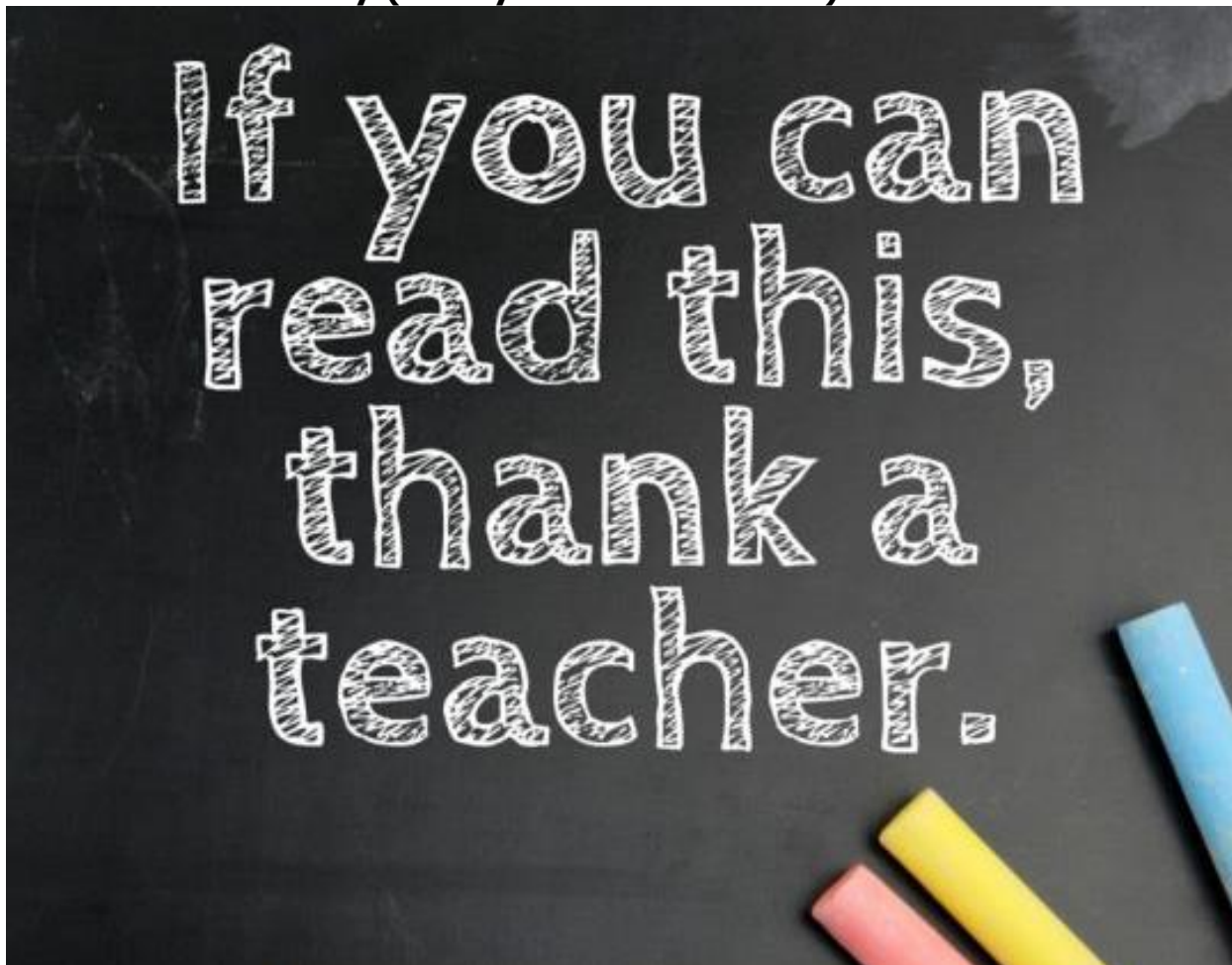
Keep your gadgets at home...no excuses

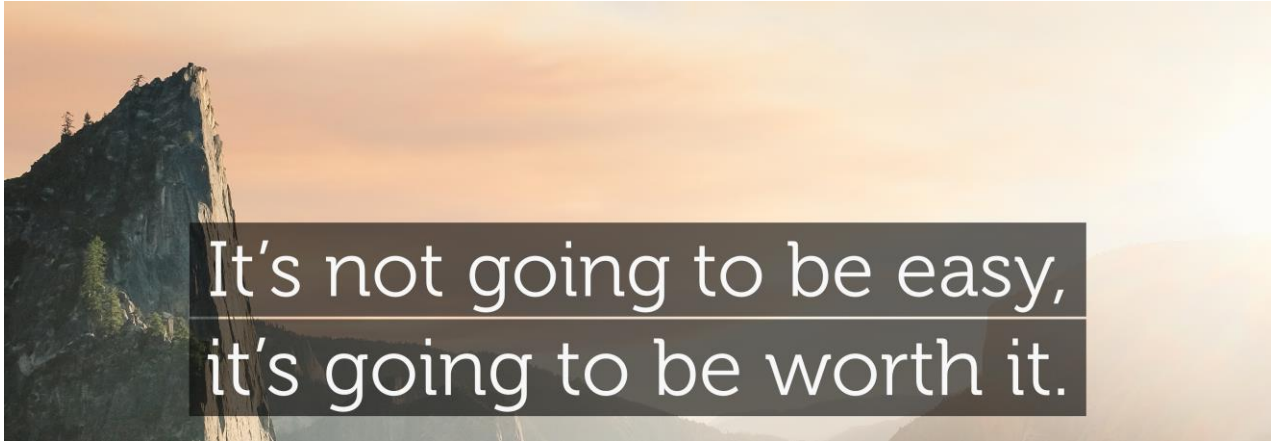
